Report of the Board Liaison to the Board of Directors

The quarterly meeting of the Quality Assurance and Program Improvement (QAPI) Committee was held on January 13, 2021. The following quarterly reports were reviewed.

Significant weight loss	No explained weight loss was noted
In-service training	Training sessions met appropriate standards
Maintenance/life safety	Audits, drills & training were appropriate
Health Center falls (minor & major)	No unusual or serious trends; compared well to benchmarks
Psychotropic utilization	At or below State or national averages or had appropriate rationale for use
Regulatory reports	One survey: closed and HOTM plan of correction accepted
CASPER Report (MDS data)	One Quality Measure was triggered for UTI with appropriate treatment
Infections (UTI, respiratory, blood, other)	No significant negative trends noted
Antibiotic stewardship	No inappropriate use noted
Contractures, range of motion, length of rehab	No inappropriate incidents or conditions noted
Theft & Loss reports	Two reports submitted: one found and other replaced by warranty
Grievance reports	None submitted
