



**Quality Assurance and Program Improvement (QAPI)
Report of the Board Liaison to the Board of Directors**

The quarterly meeting of the Quality Assurance and Program Improvement (QAPI) Committee was held on July 21, 2021. The following quarterly reports were reviewed.

Significant weight loss	No unplanned weight loss was noted
In-service training	Training sessions met appropriate standards
Maintenance/life safety	Audits, drills & training were appropriate; emergency operations plan was updated
Health Center falls (minor & major)	No unusual or serious trends; compared well to benchmarks
Psychotropic utilization	At or below State or national averages or had appropriate rationale for use
Regulatory reports	One infection control survey for this quarter; six unusual occurrences reported; pending results from one self-report in 2020
CASPER Report (MDS data)	No Quality Measure was triggered
Infections (UTI, respiratory, blood, other)	No significant negative trends noted
Antibiotic stewardship	No inappropriate use noted
Contractures, range of motion, length of rehab	No inappropriate incidents or conditions noted
Theft & Loss reports	Two reports were submitted with item found and/or replaced
Grievance reports	No report was submitted with concern resolved

Program Improvement Projects: Because of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, no additional program improvement project was initiated during the quarter and review of the Falls Improvement Plan is recommended for the next quarter.
